1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The **BRISBANE MOTORCYCLE CLUB INC**, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct **QUEENSLAND CLASSIC AND EVOLUTION MOTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP** at **104 OLD WARWICK RD; HARRISVILLE**, on **SATURDAY 27th AND SUNDAY 28th MAY 2017**.

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by **MOTORCYCLING QUEENSLAND** who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number as above and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia **NATIONAL AND ONE MEETING** Licences.
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by **MOTORCYCLING QUEENSLAND**.
BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and will be accepted ONLINE at www.nominate.com.au
- 3.1.1. Postal entries send to; **Brisbane Motorcycle Club Inc. 151 Sibley Rd; Wynnum West, 4178**
- 3.1.2. **Entries close midnight/last mail Friday MAY 19th 2017.**
- 3.2. **NOTE :- ENTRIES and or PAYMENT will NOT be accepted on the day.**
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by **BRISBANE MOTORCYCLE CLUB INC**, if such retention is approved by **MOTORCYCLING QUEENSLAND**.
- 3.3. Only entries received on the official Entry Form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

- 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

8. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

9. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

9.1. To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be as per the MoMS.(13.2.2.2; 2017)

9.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the **BRISBANE MOTORCYCLE CLUB INC**, subject to **MOTORCYCLING QUEENSLAND** approval.

10. RACE FORMAT:

Each class will be raced in four{4} Rounds of four {4} laps, conditions and circumstances permitting. There will be no semi finals or finals with all points awarded being tallied following the last race of the meeting.

10.1 Time permitting Handicap Races, A;B;C;D; will be held following the final race of the 4th round.

11. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

11.1. **All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for CLASSIC MOTOCROSS Competition. (2017 MoMS 13.)**

11.2. **Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.**

11.3. **Change of Rider and Machine may be permitted if submitted in writing to the Clerk of the Course and with the approval of the MA Steward prior to the start of the event in which the substitution is requested. Substitute machine must have been passed at machine examination. Failure of riders to follow this procedure may result in placing not being recorded**

12. RIDING NUMBERS:

12.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their Registered Riding Number or their preferred Riding Number. All others will be allocated numbers at the **BRISBANE MOTORCYCLE CLUB INC** discretion.

12.2. All Number Plates on all Machines **MUST** comply with the 2017 GCR's.

12.3. **All riders must display back numbers as per the MoMS (13.8.2.1; 2017)**

- 13 GRID POSITIONS:**
There will be no allocations of Grid Positions {first in, first choice}
- 14 RIDERS BRIEFING:**
A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing and ALL Competitors MUST attend the Riders Briefing. Details will be included in Final Instructions. RIDERS BRIEFING IS A NON SMOKING AREA.
- 15 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:**
- 15.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 15.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the **MOTORCYCLING QUEENSLAND** discretion until the results of the tests are known.
- 15.3 For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 2pm Friday 26th May with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue

1 minute after the last rider passes the chequered flag on the track from the previous race; or at the Starters discretion;
10sec Board;
5 sec Board;
30 Self Penalising Falling Gates
- 21 RACING:**
Practice will consist of 15 min periods for all 125's; all 250's; all 263cc – over; and all Sidecars.
Racing will consist of four {4} Rounds of four {4} Laps, conditions and circumstances permitting.
All Races and Practice will be run in a clockwise direction on the track.
Racing Program will be announced on the day at the Riders Briefing.

Limit dB(A) 95 {30metres from the side of the track} as per MoMS pp#319; Appendix C

23. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

Neither Motorcycling Queensland nor Motorcycling Australia nor the property owner, licensed officials nor duly appointed agents shall be responsible for any damage to or loss of any competing machine. Any entrant, by entering the event, shall hereby waive the right or action at law against the club, Motorcycling Australia, Motorcycling Queensland or the land owner for any damage sustained by him/her or their representatives or agents with respect of this competition or any matter arising there from

22.3 FOOTWEAR:

Fully enclosed footwear must be worn in the pits

22.4 CORRECT CLOTHING:

No person, unless wearing correct protective clothing and helmet, may ride a motorbike or be a passenger on a motorbike at this venue at any time

24. FACILITIES:

Camping is available Friday and Saturday night @ \$10 per site {10m x 6m} No open fires, No fire accelerants!

Toilets and hot showers are available

Food and Drinks can be purchased on Saturday and Sunday, approx. 8am to 4pm, from the Volunteer Fire Fighters, at the Venue.

25. ELECTRONIC TIMING:

24.1. *MYLAPS electronic timing will be utilised at this event.*

24.2. *It is compulsory for all competitors to have a transponder in order to compete.*

24.3. *Transponders must be fitted for all practice sessions.*

24.4. *It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is mounted correctly and securely to prevent damage from fouling other components on the machine. Cable ties will be provided. Transponder brackets can be issued with hired units. If riding more than one event the same transponder can be used.*

24.5. *The onus is on the competitor to ensure that the correct transponder is on the correct machine prior to each event.*

24.6. *All competitors are required to provide their MA Licence in exchange for a timing transponder. One Event Licence holders will be required to provide their Drivers Licence/18+ Card.*

24.7. *Transponders must be picked up and returned to the designated person/s.*

24.8. *When a hired transponder is transferred to the competitor, it then becomes the competitor's responsibility.*

24.9. *For transponders not returned on the same day, or not returned to the designated person/s, in addition to the late return fee, the hirer is responsible for the transponder until it arrives back at the designated place This includes whilst in transit with Australia Post and by Courier.*

24.10. *It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that transponders are returned in an undamaged condition at the end of the event, or if due to machine failure or injury before the machine leaves the pit area. Competitors MAY be charged an additional LATE RETURN FEE of \$20 per day per transponder for transponders that are not returned correctly.*

24.11. *There is a Fee of \$350plus GST for lost or damaged transponders.*

WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS, PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.

1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below): [Insert Name]

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

2. DEFINITIONS

- In this declaration:
- "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
 - "Indemnities" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
 - "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
 - "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
 - "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
 - "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
 - that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
 - that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
 - that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- the Indemnities do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:

- rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part.

"Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.

For the purposes of the clause 3, "the Supplier" shall mean and include the Indemnities.

5. INDEMNITY AND RELEASE GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as a participant in the Meeting:

- I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnities and each of them in the following manner:
 - that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
 - that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
 - that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnities, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.
- I AGREE TO RELEASE to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnities and each of them from all liability to me for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, psychological trauma, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) that arises as a result of any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by me or which is in any way connected with my presence at or involvement in the Event.
- The release and indemnity provided by me in this declaration is in addition to, and will not in any way limit the application of, the conditions of sale attaching to tickets, conditions of entry, conditions of credentials or any other applicable terms or conditions in respect of the Event.
- A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

6. MEDICAL

I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Meeting. I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnities will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnities (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnities and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

7. PRIVACY

I hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by the Promoter/Event Organiser, MA and the SCB in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by Event Organiser, and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my personal information held by contacting MA at 147 Montague St, South Melbourne, Victoria, 3205. I understand that if I do not provide the personal information requested above that I may not be permitted to participate in the Event.

8. PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION

I hereby agree with MA and the SCB that in consideration for my participation in the Event that MA and the SCB may receive, collect, store and use personal health information about me in the manner set out below:

- I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
 - If I am injured, become ill or die at or following the Event the party listed at Item 8 in Schedule 1 in addition to any hospital at which I am treated (together "my Carers") will have health related information about me in their possession, power and control relating to me which is subject to obligations imposed by the Privacy Act ("my Information") and the Privacy Act is intended to protect my personal information;
 - MA and my SCB wish to collect my Information for purposes that include their risk management programs, evaluating and improving

9. POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

- I acknowledge, understand and agree that it is a condition of my participation in the Event that I agree to be bound by, and subject to, the rules, regulations and jurisdiction of MA as amended from time to time. Copies of all MA rules, policies and regulations are available by contacting the MA office.
- All participants are bound by the MA anti doping policy and thus understand they may be subject to drug testing. Testing conducted by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) is in accordance with the ASADA Act and the National Anti-Doping Scheme. This involves the taking of a sample (any human biological fluid or tissue whether alive or otherwise, or any human breath) for the purpose of detecting the use of a Prohibited Drug or Doping Method. Any participant infringing MA's policy or refusing a drug test may be disqualified or otherwise dealt with in accordance with the terms of the anti-doping policy.
